Prior to joining MediaCo, Mr. McMillan served as Director of Sports Ad Sales Finance, for Univision Communications, Inc. (UCI). In this role, he worked with senior executives in the sales organization and lead the development and maintenance of revenue analytics and forecasts for UCI's portfolio of key sports properties such as the UEFA Champions League, Liga MX and the Mexican and U.S. men's national teams.

Preceding this role, Mr. McMillan served as Director of Corporate Financial Planning and Analysis, where he worked with UCI's divisional CFOs and was integral in creating and maintaining financial models used in Board-level strategic planning.
